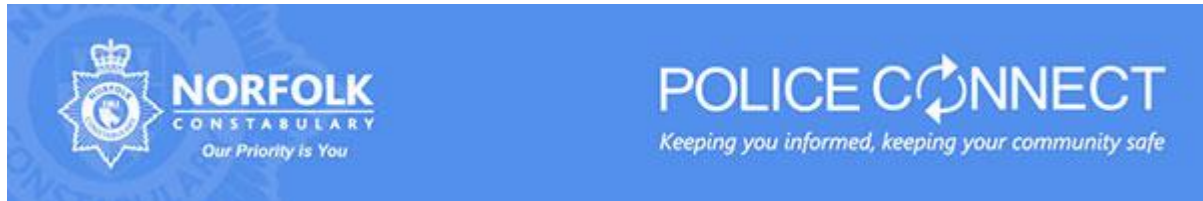


The following is a Police Connect message.
