"Service By Emergency Rider Volunteers (SERV)" is a registered charity and was started by a group of Surrey motorcyclists in 1981. They learnt that hospitals spent very significant sums of money on out of hours transport and decided to set up a professionally run medical transport service, to be offered completely free of charge, and allowing the NHS to divert funds back into patient care.

Transporting Blood, Plasma Platelets, Samples, Vaccines, Factor VIII, & other urgently required medical items to hospitals delivered out of hours.
