Are you passionate about walking, cycling and the environment? Do you have the skills and enthusiasm to help us increase access to the countryside in Norfolk? Could you volunteer about 8 hours per month to help steer our charity?

Pathmakers CIO (a charity set up by the Norfolk Local Access Forum to increase public access to the countryside, charity registration 1161475) is looking for **5 new trustees** to shape, support and future-proof the charity over the next 3 years as it enters an exciting phase of development.

The opportunity

To help us grow we are looking for experienced members of the public to join our board. We are particularly keen to recruit trustees with skills in: leadership, financial management and fund-raising, community engagement, communications and marketing, legal operating framework for small charities and project management.

These are not paid roles, but we will cover expenses.

- You will meet people from diverse backgrounds and sectors who are keen to protect the environment and to create better access.
- You will take part in four board meetings per year, offering your personal perspective and skills to certain tasks

In return for about 8 hours per month you will:

- Get the chance to develop your strategic thinking and questioning skills
- Receive full induction and training for your role as charity trustee

Recent and current Pathmakers projects include:

- Delivery of a 600 metre boardwalk at Burgh Castle
- "Community Friends Walks" to develop a Smartphone app to help people find local walking routes;
- "Liftoff" which enables small or medium-sized rural businesses offer work trials for those who might experience barriers to finding work in the environment sector;
- "Paving the Way", a bid in development to increase Pathmakers resilience through trustee learning visits and initiatives to strengthening governance.
